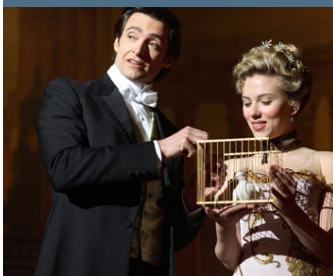

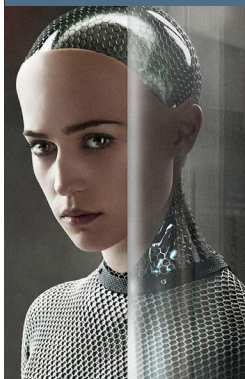


A successful business woman gets caught up in a game of cat and mouse as she tracks down the unknown man who raped her.
